Psalm 23:5



Anoint us with the oil of Your Holy Spirit. Let it saturate us until every cell in our body is dripping with the fragrance of Your love. Transform us from the inside out so Your love flows from us like fragrant oil. Please flood our souls with the expectation of Your glory. There is nothing in the world that can compare to Your presence. May our hearts always soar with thankfulness and joy. Let us drink constantly of Your truth, ruining us for anything else.

There will be an opportunity to engage in various types of prayer, such as:

1. Prayer of faith Also called the prayer of petition. Petition prayer is between you and God. It is you asking God for a particular outcome. Matthew 21:22
2. Prayer of Consecration The prayer of dedication, or to be set apart by God for His purposes. In the absence of direct instructions, you allow God to set your direction or make your decisions. Acts 13:2
3. Prayer of Commitment The prayer of committing a person, event, or circumstance to God. Acts 13:3-5
4. Prayer of Worship In this prayer, you are not asking God to do something for you or to give you something. You are not even asking for direction and dedicating your life to whatever it is God has called you to do. Rather, you just want to praise the Lord, to thank Him for His mercy & many blessings. You want to tell Him how much you love Him. The Psalms are full of prayers of worship extolling God. This is all about Him. Psalm 27:4
5. Prayer in the Spirit Prayer given in your prayer language, rather than your natural one. 1 Corinthians 14:2
6. Intercessory Prayer Intercession involves praying for others. It may involve praying in a general way for such things as the church or the government, or offering up more specific prayers based on your knowledge of a person's need. 1 Timothy 2:8
7. Soaking and Silent Prayer is simply positioning yourself to express your love to God by listening to Him. It is not intercession. It is not coming to God with a list of needs. It is the act of entering into the presence of God to hear His heart.
